Trip insurance should be purchased as soon as possible to ensure complete coverage.

PAYMENTS:

- Deposit at sign-up on April 27, 2019: \$950 Single Supplement add \$194 to payment \$1144 total
- 2nd Payment due 5/27/19 \$950 Single supplement add \$194 to 2nd payment \$1144 total
- 3rd Payment due 6/27/19 \$975 (Single supplement add \$195 to 3rd payment \$1170 total

The final payment (including Single Supplement fee) may be adjusted up or down depending on other fees or costs that may apply including those from the tour operator or from the Springfield Ski Club.

Refunds or additional payment may be required if payment in full is received prior to the adjustment.

PASSPORTS:

AT SIGN-UP, SUBMIT A COPY OF THE FIRST PAGE OF YOUR PASSPORT WHICH SHOWS YOUR PICTURE, PASSPORT NUMBER, DATE OF BIRTH, ETC. WITH YOUR TRIP APPLICATION.

Passports must be valid for 6 months after the return date for international travel.

- If you cancel after May 3, your obligation is the full price of the trip.
- If a replacement is found by June 29, an adjustment may be possible.
- No refunds are given for unused portions of the package.
- ALL CANCELLATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO \$25 SSC PRO-CESSING FEE.
- TRIP INSURANCE IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED
